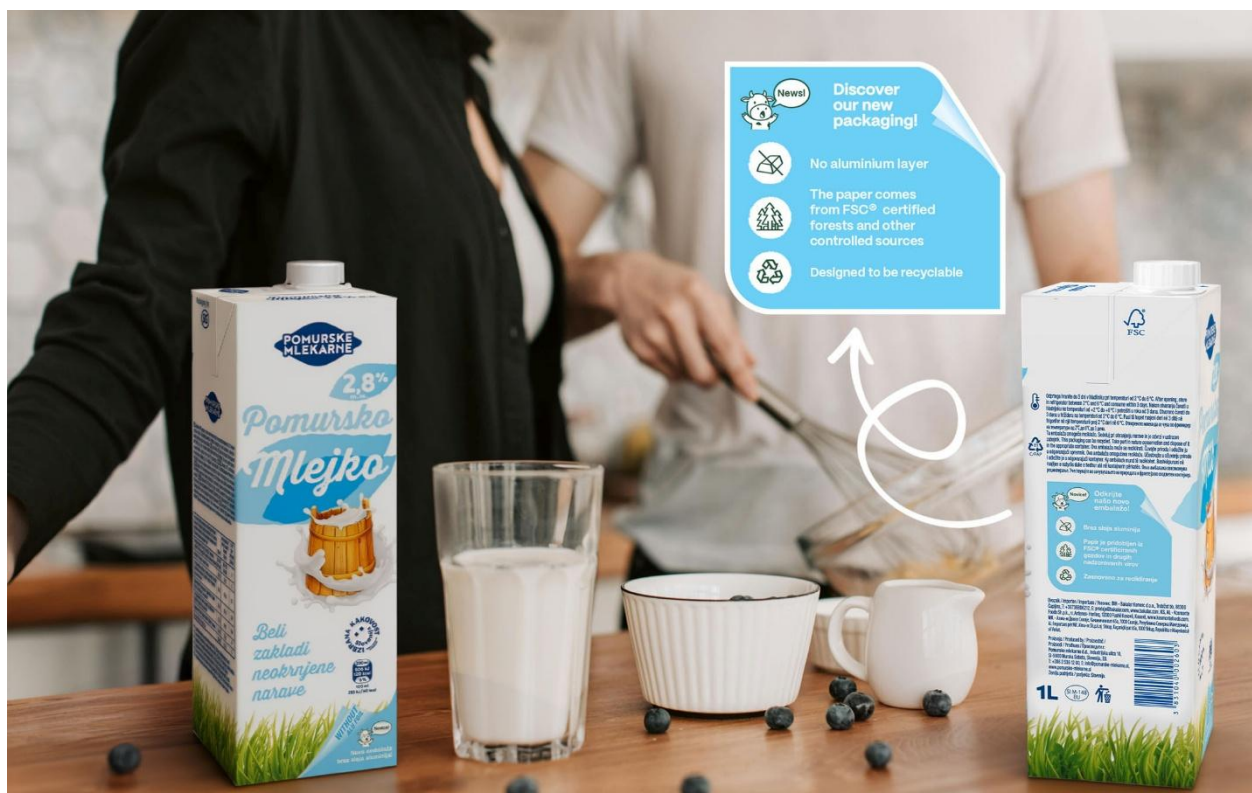

Significant milestone in sustainable innovation

## Pomurske Mlekarne first in Slovenia to introduce SIG aseptic cartons with full barrier protection and no aluminum layer

As demand for aluminum-layer free aseptic cartons continues to increase globally, Pomurske Mlekarne, a key dairy producer in Slovenia, has partnered with SIG to launch its first milk product in SIG Terra MidiBloc Alu-free + Full barrier aseptic cartons.

With a strong history of launching products in SIG carton packs, this latest relaunch of Pomurske Mlejkó 2.8% low fat milk with SIG Terra Alu-free + Full barrier packaging material marks a key milestone for the local dairy industry, offering full barrier protection with no aluminum layer.

SIG has enabled us to be first to market in Slovenia with SIG Terra Alu-free + Full barrier packaging material – a pivotal move forward in sustainable packaging for the dairy industry and an integral part of our development as we celebrate our 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year. We're excited to launch our first Pomursko Mlejkó product in the new alu-layer-free packaging material."

By removing the aluminum layer from aseptic cartons, SIG has taken a significant step forward in reducing environmental impact and towards creating a regenerative food packaging system. SIG Terra Alu-free + Full barrier packaging material is made from more than 80% paper (without closure). The aluminum layer is replaced with an ultra-thin polymer coating that protects products against oxygen, light, moisture and aroma loss. This innovation cuts the number of raw materials from three to two and significantly lowers the carbon footprint of multi-serve aseptic SIG cartons<sup>1</sup>. The packaging material is suitable for a wide range of products including dairy products, juices and plant-based beverages. Pomurske Mlekarne also benefits on the manufacturing side as SIG Terra Alu-free + Full barrier can run seamlessly on existing SIG filling lines, without compromising filling line performance. Switching between packaging material without an aluminum layer and standard packaging material is quick and easy at any time.

The first launch of aseptic cartons made of SIG Terra Alu-free + Full barrier packaging material will offer consumers an even more sustainable packaging solution with no compromise on full barrier protection or shelf life."

SIG was the pioneer in its industry to introduce a packaging material without aluminum layer for aseptic cartons in 2010 – developed for oxygen-insensitive products like plain white milk. With SIG Terra Alu-free + Full barrier SIG achieved a new milestone in packaging barrier technology with a new alu layer-free option for wider use with oxygen-sensitive products such as fruit juices, nectars, flavored milk or plant-based beverages. To date, SIG has sold a total of over 4 billion packs with no aluminum layer.
